**Outing rules -**

- Students can go on outings with parents as per the school calendar.
- Outings will not be permitted on days other than those mentioned in the calendar.
- Students must strictly adhere to the departure and return timings.
- Parents must come in person to collect and drop their child.
- If parents are unable to come in person, they must send a letter of authority by email to from an email address registered [woodbridgeschool2002@gmail.com](mailto:woodbridgeschool2002@gmail.com) with the school.
- Failure to follow the outing rules may result in students not being allowed to leave the school.

## Leave Rules –

- Boarders need **prior permission** to leave the school campus.
- Students can take leave for medical treatment recommended by the school nurse.
- Parents or guardians must request leave at least **one week in advance** for special occasions, on the email id [leaveapplication.woodbridge@gmail.com](mailto:leaveapplication.woodbridge@gmail.com).
- To apply for leave for medical treatment, students must attach a copy of the **doctor's appointment** to their application.
- Up to three days of leave may be granted for the marriage of a close relative, **provided an invitation card is presented** with the application.
- If a boarder fails to return to School by the specified date and time, he/she may have to forfeit his/her next leave.
- **No leave** will be granted **during exams**.
- If a student takes leave during his preparation period for a school event, he/she may have to forfeit his/her participation in the event.

### Outing on birthday:

For a boarder who wants to go on an outing with his parents to celebrate his/her birthday, the timings will be as follows:

#### **On weekdays or working days :**

Timings for an outing – from 2:00 pm to 5:00 pm

#### **On a Saturday or any day followed by a holiday :**

Timings for an outing – from 7:00 pm to 3:00 pm next day

**Students who are unable to report back to School on time due to medical reasons should apply along with a medical certificate endorsed by a certified medical practitioner to the School's Office.**
